- Gala: raised \$180k, after expenses approx. \$151 \$154k. Goal was \$150k.

- Money from events (Gala, Running with Rosco, Golf Tournament) is going to big initiatives
 - Jungle gym \$30k
 - Update fence trim and doors ~\$70k
 - Update PE restroom ~\$50k (other restrooms will be updated later)

- Swing set shade structure ~\$77k
