FLEECE BLANKET INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Begin with one solid-colored piece of fleece fabric and one patterned piece of fleece matching in length (3 yards cut = average size throw blanket).
- 2. Lay the patterned piece of fleece and the solid piece of fleece on top of one another. Smooth out wrinkles and match up edges as best you can. Don't pull too much as fleece has a bit of stretch to it.




3. Trim 1 inch from edges with scissors. Save the cut strips for tying later.



4. Place a square 4"x4" cardboard template in one corner of the 2 layers of fleece and cut out a square from the layered fleece, set aside. Repeat with the remaining 3 corners.



5. Using the cut out corner as a guide and a ruler, cut 1" wide strips into the edge of the layered fleece. Repeat around the entire perimeter of the layered fleece.



6. Fold up the cut strips, one at a time and carefully make a small slit on the fold. This is your hole for 'tying', so <u>the smaller the better</u>. Continue until each strip has a cut hole.



7. Carefully turn the strip up & pull down inside, through the slit. Continue until each strip is

knotted tightly.
